CLUB OUTTING AT CHEROKEE ROSE DEEMED A BLAST!



ROTARY WILL ERADICATE POLIO!

Since the inception of the Rotary Foundation's PolioPlus program in 1985, more than two million children have received oral polio vaccine. To date, 209 countries, territories, and areas around the world are polio-free. As of now, Pakistan, Nigeria, and Afghanistan are the only countries with endemic polio. Rotary has committed over \$850 million to eradication efforts. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation has donated another \$355 million. We are on the verge of conquering the poliovirus worldwide.
