

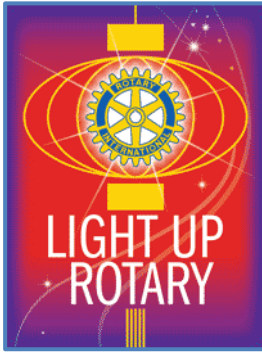

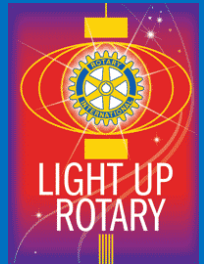
'LIGHT UP ROTARY' AT BUSINESS AFTER HOURS

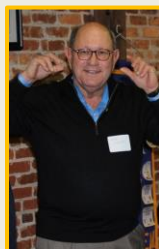
